Land Acknowledgment Statement

As part of the effort by members of First Parish Brewster UU to understand more aspects of our church's history and the impacts of that history, the church has approved this Land Acknowledgment Statement, which is intended to recognize and remind us that we live and worship on land that was stolen from indigenous peoples who had lived here and held this land sacred for thousands of years.

First Parish Brewster Unitarian Universalist occupies land that was home to the Wampanoag people for thousands of years before European colonists violated their sovereignty and assaulted their people, livelihood and culture. Acknowledging this history, we honor the resilience and strength of today's Wampanoag tribe.
